With reference to the information published by the mass media concerning a dioxin contamination on pork meat of Irish origin, the Authority of this country on the 6<sup>th</sup> of December decided to collect from the market all the pork meat and the connected products obtained by slaughtered animals starting from the 1<sup>st</sup> of September 2008.

**Thanks to our traceability procedure, we are here to guarantee to our estimated customers that the company ALCAR UNO S.p.A. has not imported pork meat of Irish origin or nationality since the 1° September 2008.** This reassurance gives to our customers a total and unequivocal guarantee of the absence of dioxin for lots received by ALCARUNO SpA.
